In order to earn the full 15 or 25 points, companies need to invest 3% of their net profit after tax. All money received is used solely for the development of future entrepreneurs.

1. Contact

2. Sign

A Memorandum of Understanding, supplied by The Hope Factory, will be signed by both companies which formalises your contribution and how it will be used.

3. BBEE Rated

An invoice will be issued to your company. Upon payment, The Hope Factory will provide you with all the relevant evidence for your BBEE rating purposes





The Hope Factory applies a funnelled approach with 3 key phases:



The Hope Factory, endorsed by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA), falls under the Enterprise Development category in the BEE scorecard, and as such funders will be able to claim 15 to 25 points in that category.

The Hope Factory has implemented a system to establish the black ownership and exempt micro status (EME) of their entrepreneurs and as a consequence the empowerment credentials of the ultimate beneficiaries are traceable.

The products manufactured as part of the Job Creation/Incubator Programme, are world class and the funding requested will also ensure the future sustainability and growth of The Hope Factory allowing for more entrepreneurs to be equipped, empowered and remain financially productive.
