

## **A genuine empowerment initiative assisting thousands of orphans through corporate contributions to Socio-Economic Development**

The Nkomazi Community Trust is a registered trust fund (Reg. No. IT11872/06) which supports one of the most disadvantaged and marginalised communities in South Africa – the orphans and vulnerable children living in the Nkomazi district of Mpumalanga. Its only beneficiaries are the more than 5500 orphans and 300 care-workers living in that area, and its funds go directly towards their educational, safety, physical and social needs.

Since commencing activities at the end of 2006, the Trust has contributed hundreds of thousands of Rand towards the needs of these children by way of food parcels, school fees and uniforms. It has been the co-sponsor of a community hall accommodating up to 1000 people which is being used by the children and youth for extra-mural activities such as song and drama productions, ballroom dancing and chess tournaments. Tertiary education and internship grants are being provided to more than a dozen young adults, and a full three year bursary worth R150,000 is the incentive prize awaiting the top orphan matriculant from the class of 2009

All of these funds have come from contributions made by companies wishing to maximize their Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) levels. The Nkomazi Community Trust is an authentic initiative positioned specifically to assist your company implement a social responsibility programme which provides the maximum corporate benefits available under the BEE Codes of Good Practice and Section 18A of the Income Tax Act.

Under Statements 700 and 807 of the Codes of Good Practice, your company can earn B-BBEE recognition for monetary contributions made towards Socio-Economic development in South Africa. The governing requirements for you to derive the maximum number of BEE points available are that your contributions must equal 1% of your annual Nett Profit after Tax, and that 75% of the beneficiaries of your contributions must be black people. Meeting these requirements will benefit large companies (turnovers above R35.0m p.a.) with 5 BEE points, and smaller companies (turnovers R5m - R35m p.a.) with 25 BEE points.

The Trust has also been recognised by the South African Revenue Services (SARS) as a Public Benefit Organisation. Through this, all donations to the Trust are fully tax exempt and tax deductible, and at the end of each tax year contributing companies receive Section 18A Tax Deductible Receipts which recognise the full value of their contributions thereby enabling them to recover the taxable portion of their contributions.
